Creates the Central Illinois Hydrokinetics Research Center. The Center will be responsible for the analysis, investigation, assemblage and institution of wave energy as an alternative source of power in Illinois.

1 AN ACT concerning energy

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General**
3 **Assembly:**

5 Section 1. Findings. The General Assembly finds and declares that energy self
6 sufficiency is a state and national goal. To this end, research should be conducted into
7 various forms of alternative energy.

9 Section 2. Hydrokinetics. The Central Illinois Hydrokinetics Research Center is hereby
10 created and to be located in Springfield Illinois.

12 Section 3. The purpose of the Central Illinois Hydrokinetics Research Center is to
13 research the most efficient methods of establishing hydrokinetic turbines in the rivers and
14 lakes of Illinois to harness and distribute energy.
