



EXECUTIVE BOARD RESOLUTION 2008-2009.8
Censure of the Comptroller

Whereas, Article I, Section F of the Model Illinois Government (MIG) Bylaws outline specific duties and responsibilities for the Comptroller; and

Whereas, The Comptroller is specifically required, by Clause 3 of Section D, to:

“The Comptroller shall secure “tax exempt” status for MIG and shall ensure that the requirements for such are met”; and

Whereas, The Comptroller is specifically required, by Clause 5 of Section D, to:

“The Comptroller shall be responsible for the arrangement of the MIG Awards Banquet and Closing Ceremonies. This shall include, but not be limited to, securing banquet facilities, caterers, proper seating, and compilation of a closing ceremony program and presentation of the MIG Awards.”; and

Whereas, Executive Board Resolution 2008-2009.1, passed by the Executive Board, outlined specific job requirements for each Executive Board member; and

Whereas, Comptroller Murphy has repeatedly failed to follow her assigned duties in accordance with the timeline, specifically failing to:

- Provide the Executive Board with criteria for awards by the end of July.
- Provide the Executive Board with the initial quotations for awards and banquets by August.
- Provide an update on awards criteria to the Executive Board by October.
- Providing the Executive Board with finalized quotes for the awards and banquet by November.
- Secure tax-exempt status, resulting in unnecessary, additional costs being incurred by the organization.
- Generally failing to provide the Executive Board with any requested information and repeatedly missing meetings.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DELEGATES OF MODEL ILLINOIS GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD HERE ASSEMBLED:

That, Comptroller Muprhy is hereby censured for her inability to perform the duties and responsibilities of her office, specifically those listed above; and

That, Continued failure to perform the duties and responsibilities of his office will result in immediate removal proceedings against Comptroller Murphy.
