**Synopsis as Introduced**

The Fountain Fund Act.

This legislation will allow the Park district of that area to remove all unwanted coinage from those areas fountains and will be put into a fund to help support MIG (Model Illinois Government). All profits from the cleaning of the fountains will be put into an account to gain interests until MIG's simulation date then will be extracted to help fund there expenses. The cleanings will be done annually. Effective immediately.

**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act to create the “The Fountain Fund Act”

3 **Be it enacted by the People of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly.**

6 1) The state will start an account for MIG with a beginning balance of \$11,000 in  
7 order to help support the MIG program.

8  
9 Taking from the account will proceed as follows.

- 10 a. The account will never have less than \$1,000 in said account at any given  
11 time.  
12 b. Withdrawing from the account can and will only be done by the “elected  
13 Governor” of MIG.

- 14  
15 2) The park district and or any other help from maintenance of state or county  
16 employed will help in this Act.  
17 They will clean out all of the public fountains in their area of the coinage and then  
18 deposit it into the account specified in section 1.

20 3) Privately owned fountains will have the option to have the fountain cleaned by the  
21 “state” or they will do it themselves.
