MODEL ILLINOIS GOVERNMENT THE WAY FORWARD ADVISORY COMMISSION

EXECUTIVE ORDER 2010-2011.1

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE WAY FORWARD ADVISORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, as Governor of Model Illinois Government, it is my duty to ensure the continued success of Model Illinois Government for years to come; and

WHEREAS, the severe economic downturn affecting our state, may adversely affect Model Illinois Government; and

WHEREAS, the organization has endured for thirty-three years, and must continue to be a successful intercollegiate government simulation; and

WHEREAS, Model Illinois Government needs an institutionalized strategic direction to help plan and guide the organization for years to come;

THEREFORE, I, Lorenzo B. Webber, Governor of Model Illinois Government, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Article V of the Illinois State Constitution of 1970 in conjunction with Executive Order 2009-2010.1 of former Governor D. McFarland, hereby order as follows:

I. CREATION

There is hereby dissolve Strategic Planning Advisory Commission and create the Way Forward Commission that will report directly to the Office of the Governor.

II. PURPOSE

In pursuit of the goals of continuing Model Illinois Government programming into the future, determining economic stability, utilizing a wide range of ideas and perceptions and seeking the advice of the current Executive Board, the Commission shall:

- A. Conduct a wide-ranging study of policies enacted in other intercollegiate legislators throughout the country, to determine what suggestions, if any, Model Illinois Government can and should utilize;
- B. Analyze Model Illinois Government's financial situation going forward. Determine what the best direction of funding for Model Illinois Government should be.
- C. Advise the current and future Executive Boards in the successful implementation of the Regional Plan and Progressive Track Plan
- D. Submit to the Governor and to the Executive Board of Model Illinois Government, no later than January 30, 2011, a report outlining its findings and recommendation regarding the Regional Plan and Progressive Track Plan in order

to promote the continued success of Model Illinois Government in the concurrent four years to come;

III. MEMBERSHIP

The Commission shall be composed of a Chairperson and at least 4 Commission Members. The Chairperson shall be Carrie Clark. Members of the commission shall be appointed by the Governor. The Commission must have at least one faculty advisor serving. However, this faculty advisor is not bound to appointment by the Governor, and may be a rotating position amongst the faculty advisors serving on the Executive Board. The Governor will serve as an Ex-Officio member of this commission.

IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This order is effective immediately.
