**Model Illinois Government  
Staff Policy  
RES 2010-2011.6  
Presented by Governor Lorenzo B. Webber  
April 25, 2010**

**WHEREAS**, It has become practice for Executive Board members to appoint to their staffs distinguished Model Illinois Government (MIG) alumni or other students that would ordinarily not fall under the jurisdiction of a member school; and

**WHEREAS**, These staff personnel serve in a wide variety of roles, all vital for the smooth conduct of the MIG simulation; and

**WHEREAS**, Every delegate is required to pay a delegate fee, sign the Delegate Code of Conduct, and abide by the MIG Constitution, Bylaws and Rules.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DELEGATES OF MODEL ILLINOIS GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE EXECUTIVE BOARD HERE ASSEMBLED:**

**THAT**, All non-delegate staff attending the 2011 MIG simulation shall pay the delegate fee no later than January 30<sup>th</sup> 2011, sign the Delegate Code of Conduct, and abide by the MIG Constitution, Bylaws and Rules; and

**THAT**, The student members of the Executive Board shall have jurisdiction over those non-delegate staff members not claimed by any member school.

**THAT**, The student members of the Executive Board shall appoint a maximum of four staff members, and is required to provide written justifiable cause for each additional member to be approved by executive board by majority vote, not including staff positions that dissolve prior to the 2010 simulation.
